



Home Learning for Reception Term 4

“Mega Machines”.

These are some possible home-learning activities for you to have a go at during term 4.

Please do not feel pressured to complete all the activities, simply pick and choose according to your child's interests and most of all have fun. We would love to see any work your child would like to bring in.

Outdoor Learning	Go on a walk and look for big machines and take photos. Talk about what you see and hear.	Make up a game which involves throwing, catching or aiming at a target. What are the rules? How do you know who has won?
Maths and Science	Count all the mega machines that you see over a week and add this number to your age. Can you write the addition number sentence?	Keep a food diary for a few days and talk about which foods are healthy and why.
Shared Learning	Look at some rhyming books together. Identify the rhyming words and make up strings of other words that rhyme with them.	Help prepare and cook some vegetables for a meal or make vegetable soup. How do the ingredients change as you cook them?
Communication	Help to make clues to set a treasure hunt for someone to follow.	Go for a walk and talk about features that you like / dislike in your local environment.
Creative Learning	Make a mega machine picture using pictures cut from magazines / collage / drawing / painting.	Make a model using left over boxes / tubes / paper etc. Talk about the shapes you have used.

Don't forget to carry on reading the books we send home and practising word cards regularly. When you do these activities please remember to write in the reading record books.
