## Maths

This term, we will be continuing to develop the children's mathematical understanding of a variety of concepts in Maths. This will be building on the work we have done so far in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and applying these skills to solve problems. We will also do daily BATs (Bonds and Tables).

## Art

The children will be using nature to inspire repeated patterns and refining their printing skills. They will be sketching and sculpting a hedgehog.

## Music

We will be learning our songs for our end of term musical. Watch this space!

## PSHE

This term we are focussing on "Good to be me" and "Growing and Changing".

## RE

We will be exploring what makes some places sacred to believers, and how we should we care for others and for the world, and why this matters.

## Geography

We will be exploring our local environment whilst learning how to use simple compass directions N S,E,W and vocabulary 'near, far, left and right' when describing features and routes. We will be comparing Woodmancote with an area in New Zealand, by looking at both human and physical features.

## English

We will continue with regular reading, spelling, punctuation and grammar work.

## Computing

The children will create an algorithm for a Beebot to follow that will take it from one side of the beebot grid to the other side.

They will then use Beebots and a Beebot grid to design a map linked with our geography work on New Zealand.

## PE/Games

This term, the children will be learning new skills in striking and fielding games.

They will also be developing their running, jumping and throwing skills in athletics.

These PE lessons are on Monday and Friday afternoon and the children must have PE kit/trainers.
