RE: Year 1 trip to the SS. Great Britain - Thursday 6th February 2020

We have arranged for Year One to visit the SS. Great Britain on **Thursday 6th February 2020**. This will be a fantastic start to our unit of work all about Isambard Kingdom Brunel.

The bus will be leaving school promptly at **8:30**, we would therefore like the children to be in school by **8:20** at the latest. They will need to have a packed lunch; wear their school uniform with sensible shoes; and bring warm clothes (gloves, hats etc.) and a waterproof coat. We will aim to arrive back for the end of the school day at **3:15**.

During the visit, the children will be given a guided tour of the SS. Great Britain; participate in a workshop to learn all about Brunel and how he designed the ship; walk around the dry dock and see underneath the ship; and visit the brand new museum, featuring artefacts that Brunel used in his engineering career.

The cost of this trip will come out of the contributions paid at the beginning of the year. If you have not paid this contribution, then please ensure this is done by **Friday 17th January** as this will also give your consent for your child to attend. Please pay this via parent pay in the usual way. Otherwise, you will have to sign a consent form that can be obtained from the office. If we do not have consent, your child will unfortunately not be able to go on the trip.

We will also be looking for a few parent volunteers to come along with us on the day. If you are able to help on the day of the trip, please let us know.
