



Dear Parents,

RE: Year 6 Residential Visit to The Pioneer Centre

I am delighted to announce that following the cancellation of the Year 6 Residential visit to Whitemoor Lakes, due to the centre not re-opening for schools this summer, we have been offered a cancellation at The Pioneer Centre, the sister site of Whitemoor Lakes.

In order to secure the booking we have to move quickly and would therefore need parents to commit to this by 6pm on Sunday 9th May.

The trip will be for 3 days and 2 nights from 7th-9th July.

The site, that is located near Kidderminster, has high ropes, abseiling, caving, archery, and an inflatable obstacle course to name just some of the activities that would be available to us. We will have a whole lodge to ourselves, effectively enabling us to form a bubble of up to 60 children and 6 members of staff. Catering will be provided in the same way as at Whitemoor Lakes.

Total Cost: £210 per pupil

£190: To be paid by 11th June (can be paid in installments up to this date).
