#### **Christmas Events**

We are currently seeing a growing number of children and staff test positive for COVID. As you may already be aware, the Government has made it very clear that schools are expected to continue operating with control measures in place. These were outlined in a previous newsletter.

We are asking for parents to bear with us as we make some difficult decisions about certain Christmas events in order that we try to limit the number of families that may need to isolate in the coming weeks. As a society we are looking forward to having a 'normal' Christmas, but in order to do so, we have had to limit some aspects of what we would normally do in school. I share your frustration when looking at society as a whole and seeing how much things are returning to normal, but with the primary year groups currently seeing growing numbers of infections, we need to limit any potential spread. Both events will be going ahead for the children, but unfortunately, with increasing numbers of children and staff having COVID we have taken the difficult decision to do both events remotely. We will be filming and posting them online.

They should be dropped off at 9.30am and picked up at 11am. Session times remain the same for those normally in on a Monday. Please let a member of staff at Little Chestnuts know if you will be brining your child in for this extra session.

## Pantomime

We are looking forward to welcoming M and M productions back to Woodmancote on 10<sup>th</sup> December. We would normally accommodate all the children in the hall for the performance, but given that the numbers of positive cases is increasing at school at the moment we will be offering all children in Reception to Year 3 the opportunity of watching the pantomime and we are looking to book a separate performance for Years 4-6.

The cost of each of these performances will be met by your generous parental contributions, so we will not be asking for any specific donations for these performances.

- you are 18+ needing your first or second dose of Pfizer
