RE: Year 1 trip to the SS. Great Britain – Thursday 2nd February 2023

We have arranged for Year 1 to visit the SS. Great Britain on **Thursday 2nd February 2023.** This will be a fantastic complement to our unit of work all about Isambard Kingdom Brunel.

The children will need to have a packed lunch, wear their school uniform with sensible shoes and bring warm clothes (gloves, hats etc.) and a waterproof coat, as much of the trip will be outdoors. We will aim to arrive back for the end of the school day at **3:15**. If you would like to order a school packed lunch, please order through the office by Wednesday 25th January.

During the visit, the children will be given a guided tour of the SS. Great Britain, participate in a workshop to learn all about Brunel and how he designed the ship, walk around the dry dock and see underneath the ship, as well as a visit to the museum that features artefacts that Brunel used in his engineering career.

Thanks to their amazing fundraising efforts, the PTA is able to contribute £5 per child for this trip, bringing the cost down to £11.00. This includes transport, entrance and the workshop. We are therefore requesting a voluntary contribution of £11.00 to be payed via parent pay in the usual way by **Friday** 6th **January 2023**. In the event of insufficient contributions, we would sadly be forced to cancel this trip.

We may also be looking for a few parent volunteers to come along with us on the day. If you are able to help on the day of the trip, please let your child's teacher know.
