As you know we have arranged for Year 3 to visit the Corinium Museum on **Friday 23rd February 2024**. This will be a fantastic complement to our unit of work all about the Romans in Britain.

The bus will be leaving school promptly at **9:00**, we would therefore like the children to be in school at **8:40**.
